

## INVITATION TO BID

### **BID NO. 04-18-19-02 "MOSS AVENUE SANITARY SEWER MAIN REPLACEMENT"**

**Closing Date/Time:** 6/25/2019 10:00 AM

**Description:** Sealed Bids for Bid No. 04-18-19-02 , "Moss Avenue Sanitary Sewer Main Replacement", Danbury, CT, Project No. 19-06 will be received at Danbury City Hall, Purchasing Agent's office, 155 Deer Hill Ave., Danbury, CT 06810 until **10:00 A.M., June 25, 2019 closing**. The City is seeking bids for the construction of replacement sewer mains in Moss Avenue. Contract Documents, plans and specifications may be obtained at the Purchasing Agent's office, City Hall, 155 Deer Hill Avenue, Danbury, Connecticut 06810 for a nonrefundable payment of forty dollars (\$40.00) per set between the hours of 8:00 am and 5:00 pm Monday through Thursday.

**Project Summary:** The scope of work comprises of all labor, tools, materials and equipment necessary to demolish and replace the existing 1000-feet +/- sanitary sewer main, sewer services, and sewer manholes on Moss Avenue from the intersection with White Street and Osborne Street, and related work and materials as shown in the Contract Drawings and outlined in the Contract Specifications. Contractor is required to provide bypass pumping at all times during demolition of the existing sewer manholes, piping, and sewer services and during the construction of the replacement sewer, sewer manholes and sewer services. A detailed bypass plan is required and must be approved by the City and Engineer prior to work commencing. City Traffic Engineer will provide Overall Traffic Detour Plan. The Contractor is required to manage the plan and phasing of on-site items. Contractor is required to place backfill, compact and install temporary pavement at the end of each work day and re-open the work area to traffic. Permanent pavement to be installed after the sewer work has been completed. Contractor is required to review all technical specifications in the bid set and adhere to all requirements outlined in the General Provisions and Technical Specifications sections of this bid package.

**Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference** will be held on **Wednesday, June 12 2019 at 2:00 P.M. in Room 3C**, third floor at the Danbury City Hall for Contractors intending to bid the project to be followed by a mandatory site inspection.

**Questions Cutoff Date and Time is noon, Monday, June 17, 2019.** All questions must be in writing and addressed to Charles Volpe, Purchasing, by email. It is the responsibility of prospective respondents to contact Charles Volpe at (203) 797-4571 to verify receipt of questions and check the website regularly for any and all updates and additional documentation that may be posted.

**Delivery of Proposals:** All sealed proposals must be addressed to: City of Danbury, **Moss Avenue Sanitary Sewer Main Replacement**, Attn: Charles Volpe and bear the name of the Respondent and their address. If delivering via private courier (such as FedEx, UPS, etc.) to: 155 Deer Hill Avenue, City of Danbury, CT 06810. If mailed via USPS, send to: Purchasing Department, City of Danbury, 06810. **Sealed Bids for Bid No. 04-18-19-02, "Moss Avenue Sanitary Sewer Main Replacement"**, Danbury, CT, will be received at Danbury City Hall, Purchasing Agent's office, 155 Deer Hill Ave., Danbury, CT 06810 until **10:00 A.M., June 25, 2019 closing** followed by the Bid Opening. Prior to the public opening of the bids, any bid submitted may be withdrawn by the bidder if said bidder discovers mathematical or clerical errors in his bid. Any such bid withdrawal may be made without penalty or prejudice. After the bids are opened, all offers will be considered firm for a period of **ninety days** and no bid may be withdrawn for any reason during that period except for such cause as the City of Danbury in its sole discretion deems sufficient.

A **Bid Bond** in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid shall accompany each bid. A non-collusion statement for Prime Contractors and any addendum acknowledgment must also be submitted at the time of the bid. A **Performance, Labor and Materials Bond** in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the accepted bid will be required. The Surety Company or Companies must be listed on the most recent IRS Circular 570. The requirements for **Prevailing Wages do apply** to the resultant contract award.

**Special Requirements:** Proposals must be properly signed, and any Addendums acknowledged, by an authorized representative of the company with the legal capacity to bind the company to the contractual agreement. The authorized representative's signature of the bid assures the company's understanding of the City's Procurement Policy.

The City of Danbury is an equal opportunity and affirmative action purchaser. Bids from all vendors, including those from MBE's, WBE's, SBE's and Section 3 Designated Enterprises are encouraged to apply. The City of Danbury reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to award the contract to the bidder deemed to be for its best interest.
