The meeting was called to order at 8:15am.

- 1) Minutes of the previous meeting: A motion was made by Robert Steinberg and seconded by Mark Chory to accept the minutes as presented. The motion passed unanimously.
- 2) Financial Statement: After discussion, a motion was made by Robert Steinberg and seconded by Mark Chory to accept the financial statements as presented. The motion passed unanimously.
- 3) Chairman's report: The Chairman discussed the business practice of one of his tenants, Empire of the Incas and the correlation of the downtown visitors. Discussion on the CityCenter district and how to encourage visitors and businesses.
- 4) Director's report:
 - a. Handicap parking policy: Debbie has not heard back from the Mayor concerning the proposed policy. She will follow up prior to the next meeting.
 - b. Main Gate at Patriot: Debbie submitted an estimate from Overhead Door Company of Brookfield for a new main gate. Due to the cost, it was decided that repairs be made to the current door rather than replace it at this time.
 - c. Farmers Market: The market is once again on the Green. One hundred and eighty one attendees parked in the garage on the first day.
 - d. Keeler Street: It was reported that Keeler Street is scheduled to become a one-way street. We have already begun preparing meters to install on the entire north side of the street.
 - e. West Street: Due to the newly installed crosswalk/light system installed at Foster and West, 6 meters will need to be removed from the area.

- 7) Adjournment: A motion was made by Mark Chory and seconded by Robert Steinberg to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 am. The motion passed unanimously
